ABDOMINAL SONOGRAPHY

Static images were obtained during real time sonography of the abdomen.

History: Post operative colon cancer.

The aorta measures 2.2 cm. proximally by 1.9 cm. mid portion by 1.4 cm. in its distal portion. No evidence of aneurysm or significant stenosis detected. Flow velocities are also unremarkable measuring 0.29 m/sec proximally, 0.36 m/sec mid portion and 0.33 m/sec distally.

The liver and spleen outline normally without evidence of ductal dilatation or mass.

The gallbladder is unremarkable without evidence of calculi.

No intra or extra hepatic biliary distention noted. The common bile duct is normally measured at 0.5 cm.

The pancreas is not visualized due to overlying gas.

The right kidney measures 11.2 cm. in length by 4.2 cm. in AP dimensions. The left kidney measures 11.6 cm. in length by 4.7 cm. in AP dimensions.

There is a heterogeneous hypoechoic mass present surrounding the anterior margin of the left kidney. CT advised for further evaluation, particularly given the history.

There is no perinephric abnormality and no solid mass noted. There is no hydronephrosis apparent and normal cortical medullary separation is noted.

IMPRESSION: MASS SUSPECTED IN THE REGION OF THE RIGHT RENAL FOSSA FOR WHICH CT IS URGED FOR FURTHER EVALUATION.
